### **Gratefulness Gathering**

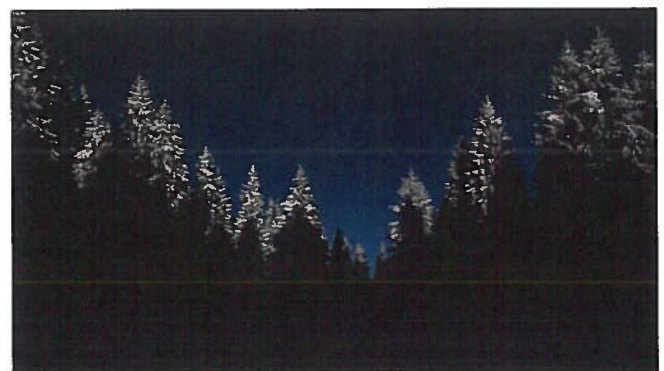
**Tuesday, January 29, 6-7 p.m.**
